HIS 100: HISTORY OF PENTECOST

Professor Donald Barber

A short history of the Pentecostal movement from the Apostolic to the modern era is given. The history of Pentecostal organizations and the lives of Pentecostal stalwarts are reviewed.

CED 105: CONFLICT RESOLUTION & FORGIVENESS

Dr. Priscilla Brown

This course examines the work of forgiveness in resolving personal and corporate conflicts in the body of Christ. This course will also include scriptural conflicts and their resolution. Students will learn the difference between restoration, reconciliation and repairing according to the Word of God.

CED 432: WOMEN AND THE CHURCH

THE 204: HERMENEUTICS I

Professor Duane Odom

This course helps the student develop the ability, through study, to gain proper understanding of Scripture. Various principles are treated as tools for biblical understanding. Biblical characteristics are examined, which enhance scriptural clarity.

THE 201: PRINCIPLES OF THE APOSTOLIC DOCTRINE (APOSTOLICITY)

Professor Beverly Howard

This course gives special attention to the foundational tenets of the Apostolic Faith. It is an important course for those wishing to understand and articulate the beliefs and concerns of the particular church movement.

CED 606: SPIRITUAL FORMATION

Dr. Mary F. Jordan

This course explores the historical development, the biblical teaching, and contemporary practice of spiritual formation. Attention will be given to spiritual disciplines such as walking in the spirit, repentance, prayer, fasting, worship and scripture meditation with a view toward the development of the student's own spiritual life.

ENG 600: EDUCATIONAL RESEARCH & WRITING PREP (6-weeks)

Professor Martin Prince

Focus: Thesis & Disseertation Writing

This course is designed for students to research methodologies, planning and structure for the Thesis writing project. The individual will learn data gathering techniques and develop materials into a unified thesis or dissertation.

BIB 102: NEW TESTAMENT SURVEY

Dr. Antwon Martin

An analysis of the New Testament books surmising their purpose, themes, authors, and dates written. Special attention is given to the synoptic gospels.
